### Switching – Allied Health

In early 2019, Hamlyn Views received a Healthy and Connected Communities Grant through the City of Greater Geelong. With this support, the school purchased a number of switches, voice recording switches, interfaces (to connect to computers and tablets) and cause and effect toys. Our students have been practicing with these to increase their ability to access technology and ways to increase their independence, which has included accessing computer and communication programs. By getting the concept of cause and effect, our students will hopefully understand that when they do something meaningful such as press the switch, they will cause something to happen such as turn on a fan, or ask for a drink. Some of our students have used the voice operated Step By Step switches to make the requests in community facilities such as the post office. We hope that this can be generalised further into the future to be a useful tool in the community, and build on the community's exposure to use of such tools so more people are familiar with them. If you want to know more, speak to our Allied Health staff who can give you more information.

#### **School Review**

Monday was the first day of our School Review. Planning went ahead for Validation Day on the 10th of March, when the review panel will visit classrooms and conduct focus group discussions with some of our students about their learning and successes.
